A BRIEF GUIDE FOR ELECTRONIC JOURNALS

What are Electronic Journals?

Electronic journals are digital versions of academic journals that are available either for free online (open access journals) or through a subscription.

Which Electronic Journals are available through the HOU Library?

The collection of electronic journals provided by the Hellenic Open University (HOU) Distance Library and Information Center includes:

- A large number of electronic journals (over 14,500 titles) available through the HEAL-Link portal. The HOU Library has access to this portal as a member of the Hellenic Academic Libraries Link (HEAL-Link). Through HEAL-Link, students and staff can access the full text of internationally recognized journals from major academic publishers such as ACM, Cambridge University Press, Elsevier, IEEE, Kluwer, Oxford University Press, Springer, Taylor & Francis, Wiley, and others.
- Additional subscriptions maintained independently by the HOU Library. These
 cover the academic fields of the University's four Schools: Humanities, Social
 Sciences, Science and Technology, and Applied Arts and Sustainable Design.

How can you search all the Electronic Journals available through the Library with a single search?

You can search using the **Summon Discovery Service** (the Library's Unified Search Tool for Electronic Resources). Use a keyword in English language that relates to your topic, and then click on the search icon.






In the search results, you receive a large number of records. To narrow down the results, you should use the filters available on the left side of the screen.

For example, from the **Advanced Search** options, you select:


- Full Text Online
- From Content Type, you choose Journal Article
- From **Publication Date**, you choose **3 years** (articles published in the last three years)
- From **Discipline**, you choose **Education**

These filters will help you focus on the most relevant academic content for my topic.






The results are automatically narrowed down to include only electronic journals that provide full-text PDF articles and are strictly related to the field of **Education**.




Where can you find Electronic Journals on the Library website?

From the Library website http://lib.eap.gr by following this path:

Online Sources \rightarrow Heal-Link



Or by selecting **Online Sources** \rightarrow **E-Journals**.



Access Rights

Full-text access is available **only to members of the Hellenic Open University academic community** (students, teaching staff, and PhD candidates), and **only** when accessing the resources through the official links provided on the Library website: $http://lib.eap.gr \rightarrow Online Sources \rightarrow E-Journals or Online Sources \rightarrow Heal-Link.$

Access requires using the **username and password** that members use for the HOU online learning platform (**Note: NOT your academic email credentials**).

External users can access the resources only from the computers available on-site at the Library.


How can you search for an article in the Library's Electronic Resources?

First, you search the Internet by typing the **title of the article** and you collect the rest of the necessary information (such as the **journal title**, **volume or issue number**, **author(s)**, and **page numbers**).

Then, you visit our Library's website (lib.eap.gr) and go to the **Electronic Resources** section to check whether full-text access is available.

A) Select "Electronic Journals", where you can browse a list of journals subscriptions, organized **alphabetically** and **by School**.





Next, you check whether the journal title you are interested in, is available - for example the journal from the School of Social Sciences titled "Decision Analysis."



The American Statistician (1997-): περιλαμβάνει άρθρα που αφορούν τους τομείς της στατιστικής πρακτικής, της ιστορίας, της εκπαίδευσης, των γραφικών τεχνών, κριτικές βιβλίων και εκπαιδευτικού υλικού. 12. California Management Review (Fall 2020 –): ορίζει τη διαχείριση σε γενικές γραμμές, με ιδιαίτερη έμφαση στην εταιρική στρατηγική και την καινοτομία, τη διαχείριση της τεχνολογίας και τον κοινωνικό αντίκτυπο των επιχειρήσεων. 13. Decision Analysis (2004-): αφιερωμένο στη θεωρία, εφαρμογή και διδακτική της ανάλυσης για τη λήψη αποφάσεων.

You locate the specific issue of the journal through the "List of Issues" archive, where all published issues are organized by year.






Then, you select the **year** and the **volume** in which you know the article you are looking for, is included.




Alternatively, within the journal's **Search** engine, I type keywords or phrases that I want to appear in the titles of the published articles and then I download the related PDF file.




B) Select "Heal-Link", where the Quick Search engine allows you enter the title of the journal (not the article title). For example, you type "Management Learning".





Alternatively, you can search for electronic journals in the following ways:

- by title
- by subject
- by publisher
